Secretary Report

Treasurer's Report

Balance at end of year £25555.00 credit. We had an income of £7446.20 plus £1033 grant monies, total £8479.20. Our out goings were £17615.96 leaving us a loss of £9136.76.

Our regular groups income has increased due to most groups not taking breaks for school holidays. Private hire has also increased following a couple of quite years due to restrictions. Payments include refund from ESBC council tax under the discretionary rate relief scheme and donations for equipment hire.

Our expenditure is for refurbishments is for digging out the bank, the rebuilding of the wall to stop the damp and redecorating. We have also refurbished the bridge to ensure it is safe. Our main increase in outgoing is the cost of electricity, which has more than doubled over the previous year, now standing at £316 per month.

Dave Roycroft ACIB audited the accounts.

Budget

We are looking at a shortfall of approximately £2000 for the coming year due to increased prices of electricity, insurance and other amenities.
